

General Precautions

- 1 To eliminate a choking hazard for young children, discard all packaging materials immediately upon unpacking.
- 2 Close supervision is needed when used by persons with reduced physical, sensory or mental capabilities or lack of experience and knowledge unless they have been given supervision or instruction concerning use of the appliance in a safe way and understand the hazards involved.

- 6 DO NOT overfill the water reservoir. Fill water only to the Fill Lines.
- 7 ALWAYS place a vessel on the drip tray when dispensing water.
- 8 DO NOT open the Flavor Carriage or move the unit during a cycle process.
- **9 DO NOT** use outdoors.
- 10 DO NOT leave in direct sunlight.

Flavor Drops

- 1 Only use flavor drops intended for this appliance. **DO NOT** force them into the appliance.
- 2 DO NOT put Flavored Water Drops in the refrigerator.
- 3 Flavor Pods should be disposed of 30 days after being opened.
- 4 ALWAYS dilute Flavored Water Drops through machine. Flavored Water Drops are concentrated flavor, **DO NOT** consume as drops.
- **5** Ninja Thirsti Energy Flavor Drops are intended for adult use. Consume caffeine in moderation. consult your doctor if pregnant, nursing, or sensitive to caffeine.

Water Reservoir

- **1 DO NOT** fill water reservoir with anything other than non-carbonated plain water, as other liquids will damage the product and present additional safety risks and injury.
- 2 DO NOT leave water reservoir in a hot vehicle.
- 3 DO NOT use the water reservoir to store food.
- 4 DO NOT place water reservoir in freezer.
- 5 USE ONLY filtered or drinking-quality water in this system.

Carbon Dioxide CO2 Canister

- 1 Contents under pressure: May explode if heated. Keep out of direct sunlight and DO NOT expose the CO₂ Canister to heat above 120°F/50°C. Store in a well-ventilated area. DO NOT remove a CO₂ Canister from the product when it is being operated.
- **2 DO NOT** use if wrap, seal, or valve appears to be damaged or tampered with. Inspect the CO₂ Canister and CO₂ Canister valve prior to use for dents, punctures, or other damage. If damaged, contact ninjakitchen.com/support.
- **3** To reduce the risk of a CO₂ leak, **ONLY** hand-tighten the CO₂ canister. **DO NOT** use tools. This can damage the product and the O-ring or CO₂ Canister. This may result in an uncontrolled flow of CO₂ gas, causing the product to over pressurize and result in personal injury or property damage.
- **4 DO NOT** tamper with the CO₂ Canister in any way, including puncturing, incinerating, or removing the valve.
- 5 DO NOT handle or remove a CO₂ Canister while it is discharging CO₂.


Care & Maintenance

PREPARING FOR FIRST USE

BEFORE FIRST USE

- 1 Remove and discard any packaging material, stickers, and tape from the unit.
- Pay particular attention to operational instructions, warnings, and important safeguards to avoid any injury or property damage.
- **3 NEVER** put the Ninja Thirsti base unit in the dishwasher.

NOTE: ONLY carbonate still water.

4 Place the Ninja Thirsti base on a stable, flat surface and plug in.

RINSE CYCLE

- 1 Place 12oz. cup on the hinged cup tray or bottom drip tray.
- 2 Fill the water reservoir with cold filtered water and place Water Reservoir docking station.
- 3 Select STILL by toggling the ⊛ button until the light below "Still" is illuminated.
- 4 Press the 🖾 button to select 12oz. dispense size.
- **5** Ensure Mixing Chamber is installed into Flavor Carriage and in raised position.
- 6 Press the "Start" button to start the Rinse Cycle.
- **7** Dispose of the dispensed water once the Rinse Cycle is complete.

INSTALLING CO₂ CANISTER

Open the CO₂ door at the back of the unit.



- 2 Swing the CO₂ cover out of the unit.
- Insert the CO₂ canister into the CO₂ cover. Applying gentle pressure, turn to the right until tight.



4 Press CO₂ canister into unit. Close the door.


HOW DO I KNOW CO₂ IS PROPERLY INSTALLED?

- 1 Canister cannot be turned anymore.
- 2 Carbonation is present in Sparkling drinks.
- **3** There is no hissing sound from the back of the unit when making a sparkling drink.

PREPARE WATER RESERVOIR

- Fill water reservoir with ice and cold, filtered water.
- TIP: Filtered water guarantees a clean, clear taste.
- 2 Place water reservoir on the Water Reservoir dock. Measurement gradients should face forward when properly installed.

NOTE: Check the Cold Water Indicator at the bottom of the reservoir. The brighter the blue, the colder the water, the fizzier the drink.



TIP: Store Water Reservoir in fridge when not in use.

INSTALLING THIRSTI FLAVORED WATER DROPS


Flavored Water Drops Bottles are designed to be interchangeable between drinks for endless drink customization.

INSTALL

1 Remove safety seal.



2 Flip the cap into the open position. The cap will click into place on the backside of the Flavored Water Drops bottle.




3 Lower the Flavor Carriage to open.



4 Flip the Flavored Water Drops so the nozzle is down and gently insert it into the Flavor Carriage. An audible click indicates proper installation.



- Repeat with a second Flavored Water Drops bottle if a combo beverage is desired.
- 6 Raise the Flavor Carriage to close.



SETTING UP YOUR NINJA THIRSTI DRINK SYSTEM CONT.

REMOVING THIRSTI FLAVORED WATER DROPS

- 1 Lower the Flavor Carriage to open.
- **2** Remove the Flavored Water Drops and snap cap into the closed position.



NOTE: Flavor drops have a shelf life of 30 days once opened.

NOTE: It is recommended to store Flavored Water Drops in a cool, dark place to further maintain aroma, color and taste.

CO2 LOW WARNING

When the B button turns orange there is approximately 25% CO₂ remaining, or enough for approximately 25 12oz. drinks. The B button will remain orange until a new CO₂ canister is installed and the indicator is reset.

Once a new CO₂ canister has been installed, reset the indicator by pressing and holding the [®] button for 3 seconds or until it turns from orange to white.


NOTE: Only reset the indicator when a new canister has been installed.

NOTE: Only use Ninja Thirsti CO₂ Canisters for best carbonation results.

REPLACING CO₂ CANISTER

- 1 Open the CO₂ door at the back of the unit and swing out the CO₂ canister.
- **2** Slowly twist the CO₂ canister to the left until it releases from the unit.
- **3** Follow the installation directions to install a new CO₂ canister.
- 4 Press and hold the (2) button for 3 seconds. When the button illuminates white or a beep is heard, the CO₂ has been reset to accurately notify when carbonation is running low.





USING THE CONTROL PANEL

- 1 Sparkling Strength Button *Number of Sparkling levels will vary by model
- 2 Size Button
- 3 Flavor 1 Strength Button
- 4 Flavor 2 Strength Button
- 5 Start Button
- 6 Drain When drain is blinking, press "Start" to proceed

USING YOUR NINJA THIRSTI DRINK SYSTEM

SETUP CHECKLIST

- 1 Ninja Thirsti Drink System is plugged in.
- 2 CO₂ is tightly installed.
- 3 The reservoir is filled with cold water and placed on the docking station.
- 4 Desired Flavored Water Drops are installed.

GET STARTED DRINK MAKING

- 1 Press 🛞 button to toggle between Low, Medium, or High Sparkling.
- 2 Press 💮 button to select 6oz., 12oz., 18oz., or 24oz. dispense volume.
- **3** Press the <u></u> button or <u></u> button to toggle through No Flavor (0 LEDs illuminated), Classic Flavor (1 LED illuminated), and Bold Flavor (2 LEDs illuminated) strengths.
- 4 Press 📼 button to start drink making.
- **5** The Beverage Dispense Light will turn on while the beverage is dispensing. Once the beverage is complete, the light will turn off and an audible end tone will be heard.

NOTE: Combining two flavors is NOT available when 6oz. dispense size is selected.

NOTE: Always empty the Drip Tray Bucket before, or as soon as the orange full indicator appears.

CLEANING & MAINTENANCE

DISHWASHER-SAFE PARTS

Drip Tray and Drip Tray bucket are top-rack dishwasher safe.

CLEANING WATER RESERVOIR

Empty the reservoir and remove the cold water indicator. Clean with warm, soapy water. To clean more thoroughly, use a soft foam brush.

CLEANING FLAVOR FUNNEL


Remove the flavor funnel and clean with warm soap and water as needed.

CLEANING FLAVOR CARRIAGE

To clean the flavor carriage, use a damp towel and wipe gently. We recommend monthly cleaning.

CLEAN CYCLE

is recommended to run a Clean Cycle on your Ninja Thirsti Drink System every month or before storage.



- **1** Create a cleaning solution by combining 12oz. of water and 12oz. of white vinegar in the water reservoir.
- 2 Place the water reservoir with the cleaning solution on the docking station.
- **3** Place a large (24oz.) vessel on the drip tray.
- **4** To start the Clean Cycle, simultaneously hold down the 🛞 button and 📖 button for 3 seconds.
- **5** Once the Clean Cycle is complete, empty any leftover cleaning solution and rinse the water reservoir.

NOTE: The clean cycle could take up to 15 minutes

6 Refill the water reservoir with 24oz. of fresh water and repeat the clean cycle to flush the vinegar from the unit.

IMPORTANT: DO NOT remove the 24oz. vessel at any time during the clean cycle.

HELPFUL TIPS

SYSTEM TIPS

- NEVER put the water reservoir or Flavored Water Drops in the freezer.
- **ALWAYS** store water reservoir in the refrigerator for cold, ready-to-carbonate water.
- Set your refrigerator to 37°F to ensure water will reach optimally cold temperature.
- **ALWAYS** empty the drip tray before or as soon as the orange "full" indicator is visible.

BEVERAGE MAKING TIPS

- The colder the water, the greater the carbonation.
- Higher carbonation enhances the sweetness of the Flavored Water Drops.
- Each 60L CO₂ Canister will make 50-100 12,oz. drinks depending on level of carbonation.

TROUBLESHOOTING GUIDE

HOW DO I TURN MY THIRSTI DRINK SYSTEM OFF?

- The Thirsti Drink System will enter a sleep mode after 10 minutes of no use. To wake the system, press any button.
- To completely shut down the Thirsti Drink system, unplug the unit.

WHY IS MY UNIT NOT CARBONATING?

- Ensure CO₂ canister is fully installed inside the CO₂ door. If canister can still turn to the right, continue to twist until it can no longer turn.
- Reminder to only use Ninja Thirsti CO₂ canisters as other screw in style canisters might not be compatible. HOW DO I ENTER ULTRA LOW SPARKLING MODE?

 Use Ultra Low Carbonation to make a very lightly carbonated drink. To initiate Ultra Low sparkling, hold down the 🛞 button + 🕕 button. A single Sparkling LED will blink to confirm Ultra Low Sparkling state has been entered. Ultra Low Sparkling will turn off when another Sparkling level is chosen or the unit is unplugged and plugged back in.

WHY IS THE BUTTON ORANGE?

- The Sparkling button turns orange to indicate low CO₂. When the button turns orange, there is enough CO₂ for approximately 25 12oz. drinks.
- After installing a new canister, reference pg, 5 for instructions on resetting the CO₂ Low indicator.

DID YOU END YOUR CYCLE BY PRESSING START?

 If you pressed the start button during a cycle the product will prompt you to drain. See below for instruction on completing a Drain Dispense.

WHY IS "DRAIN" SHOWING ON MY UNIT?

 If the last dispense cycle was interrupted, then water must be drained from the unit. Place a cup under the nozzle and press the start button to allow a Drain Dispense to complete. The unit must run a Drain Dispense before another drink can be made. Always empty the Drip Tray Bucket before, or as soon as the orange full indicator appears.

WHY WON'T MY UNIT RUN?

- Check that the Mixing Chamber is installed into the Flavor Carriage and in the raised position.
- Ensure the unit is plugged into a working outlet. The display panel will illuminate when power is detected.
- Ensure water has been added to the water reservoir and there is no blockage on the docking station.

WHY CAN'T I MAKE A COMBO DRINK ON 60Z?

• The combo function is only available when a 12oz., 18oz., or 24oz. size is selected.

BEVERAGE DISPLAY LIGHT IS BLINKING.

• An error has occurred. Unplug the unit and reseat the water reservoir, ensuring it is filled. Wait 30 seconds before plugging back in. If the issue persists, contact Ninja Customer Support.

NO OR LOW FLAVOR IN DRINK.

- Remove Flavored Water Drops from Flavor Carriage and ensure that it is not empty. When empty, the Flavored Water Drops bottle will feel light and have a minimal amount of flavor left inside.
- Install the Flavored Water Drops into the Flavor Carriage, ensuring it is seated completely and the Mixing Chamber is in the raised position. Set corresponding flavor strength on the display panel to Classic or High strength.

WHY IS WATER SPLATTERING?

 Some splatter is normal. Use the cup tray, when possible, to reduce the distance between the cup and the dispense outlet.

WHY DOES MY SYSTEM FLASH DIFFERENT COLORS WHEN I OPEN THE FLAVOR CARRIAGE?

• The Ninja Thirsti features innovative flavor line detection. The flashing occurs to signify to the machine to dispense the correct amount of fluid based on the type of Flavor Water Drops installed.

The One (1) Year Limited Warranty applies to purchases made from authorized retailers of SharkNinja Operating LLC. Warranty coverage applies to the original owner and to the original product only and is not transferable.

SharkNinja warrants that the unit shall be free from defects in material and workmanship for a period of one (1) year from the date of purchase when it is used under normal household conditions and maintained according to the requirements outlined in the Owner's Guide, subject to the following conditions and exclusions:

What is covered by this warranty?

- 1. The original unit and/or non-wearable parts deemed defective, in SharkNinia's sole discretion. will be repaired or replaced up to one (1) year from the original purchase date.
- 2. In the event a replacement unit is issued, the warranty coverage ends six (6) months following the receipt date of the replacement unit or the remainder of the existing warranty, whichever is later. SharkNinja reserves the right to replace the unit with one of equal or greater value.

What is not covered by this warranty?

- 1. Normal wear and tear of wearable parts (such as blending vessels, lids, cups, blades, blender bases, removable pots, racks, pans, etc.), which require regular maintenance and/or replacement to ensure the proper functioning of your unit, are not covered by this warranty. Replacement parts are available for purchase at **ninjaaccessories.com**.
- 2. Any unit that has been tampered with or used for commercial purposes.
- 3. Damage caused by misuse, abuse, negligent handling, failure to perform required maintenance (e.g., failure to keep the well of the motor base clear of food spills and other debris), or damage due to mishandling in transit.
- 4. Consequential and incidental damages.
- 5. Defects caused by repair persons not authorized by SharkNinja. These defects include damages caused in the process of shipping, altering, or repairing the SharkNinia product (or any of its parts) when the repair is performed by a repair person not authorized by SharkNinja.
- 6. Products purchased, used, or operated outside North America.
